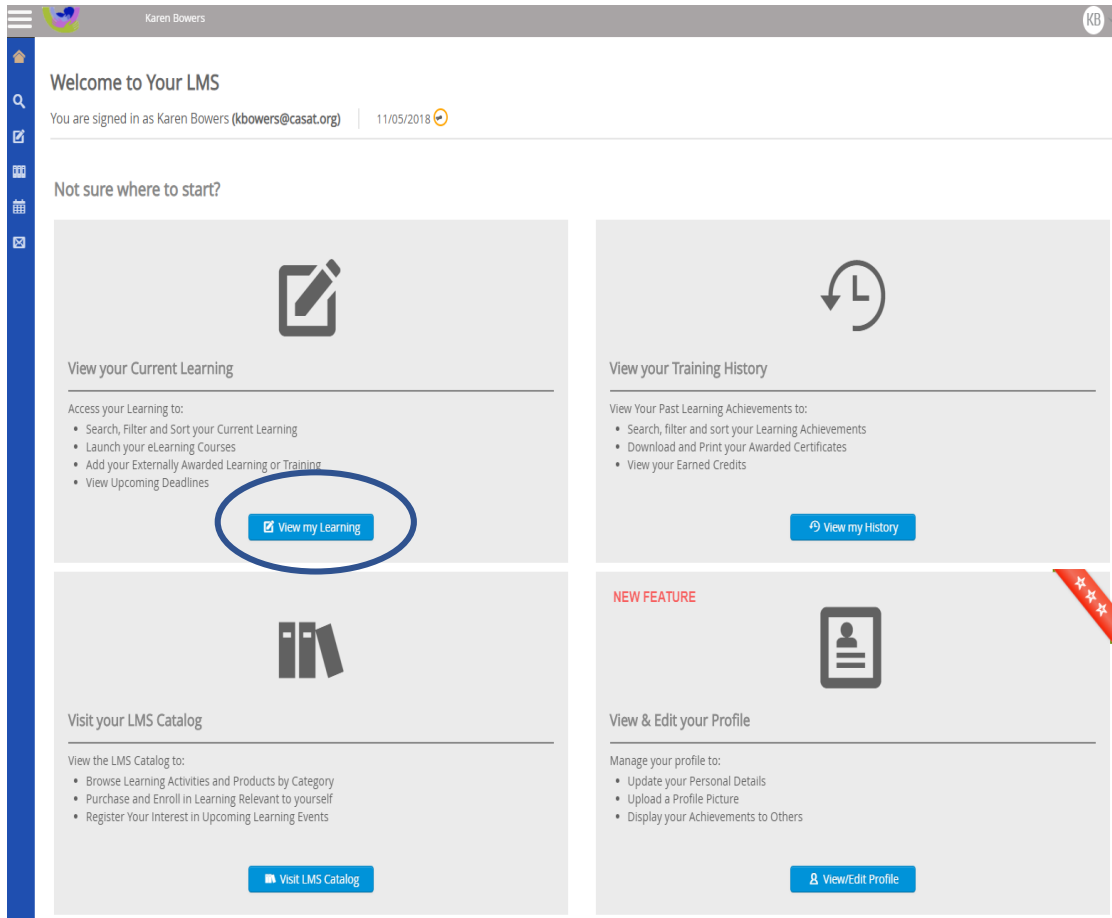

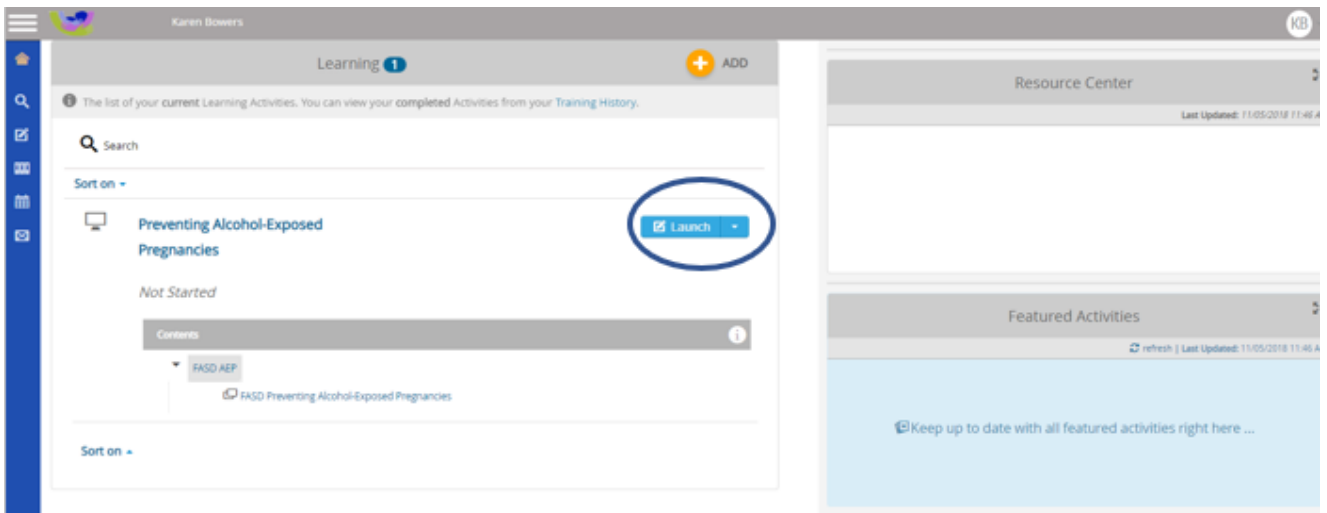

5: After logging in you will be taken to the home page. Click on **View my Learning**



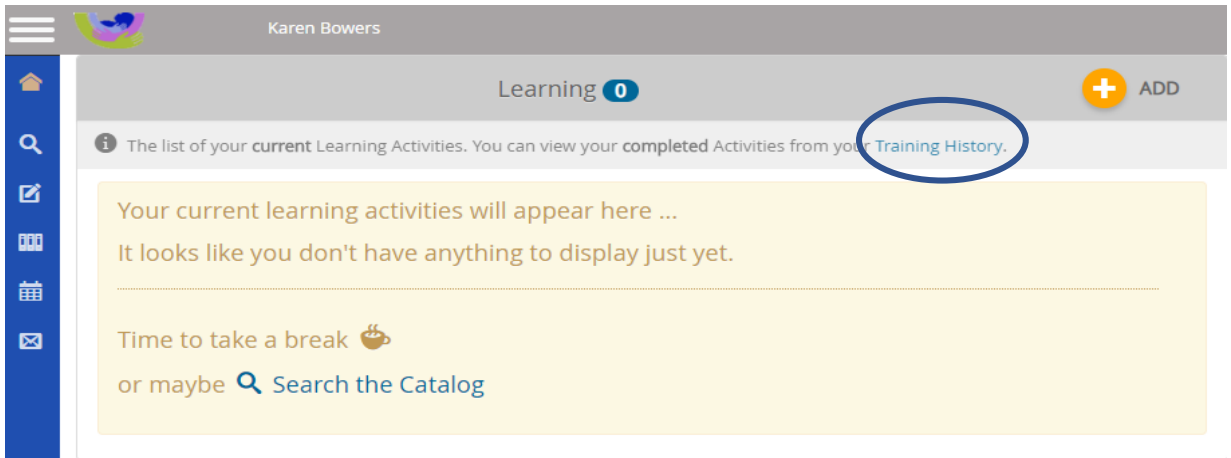
6: This will show the course that you chose to take from Step 2

7: Click the **Launch** button next to the course name

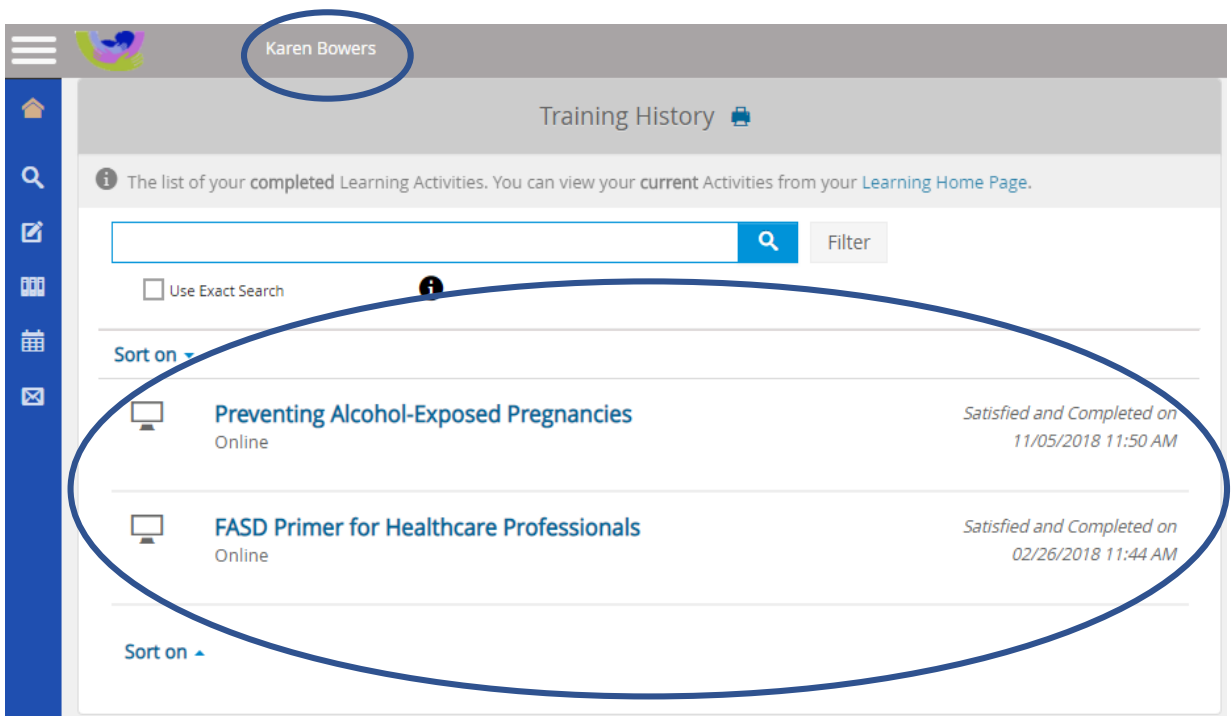


8: Launching the course will start the course. Go through all sections of the course until you have completed it. After finishing a section you can pause and come back later.
